Our services



Registered with and regulated by the Care Quality Commission (CQC), you can relax in our clinic, assured of care and attention, as we listen to your concerns and needs, from a consultation through to creating a beautiful new smile. Treatment options will be explained to you, so that you can make an informed choice.

TREATMENTS INCLUDE:

Tooth Whitening

We use an advanced and simple method from Optident, to lighten the colour of your teeth; with an initial surgery boost and then completion at home.

Cosmetic Restorations - Natural coloured fillings

Metal and discoloured fillings can be replaced by naturally coloured restorations, matching your teeth and improving the look of your smile. Many chipped, fractured and worn teeth can also be "invisibly repaired" with our new generation of tooth coloured composite restoratives.



Porcelain Veneers - Smile Makeovers

Veneers provide a wafer thin covering to hide discoloration on teeth, reshape teeth and close gaps with little work being needed on the tooth itself.

Crowns & bridges - Smile Makeovers

Heavily filled and broken teeth can be covered with crowns and spaces between teeth can be filled using bridges. Advances in ceramic technology allow these teeth to appear natural and black lines around gum margins are less likely to occur.

Implant restorations

Dental implants are permanent, fixed replacements for missing teeth; they look like, feel like and are as robust as your natural teeth. A series of implants can be used to replace dentures. Our clinic concentrates on using the Bicon system.

Hygiene services

Our hygienists work closely with the dentist to prevent and treat gum disease. They provide routine 'scale and polish' appointments to remove tartar from teeth and will advise you on oral hygiene routines to help you maintain your healthy gums.

We offer night and day guards to prevent the teeth clenching and grinding, thus eliminating the side effects from this common problem e.g. tooth damage, sensitive teeth, headaches and jaw

Sleepwell[™] is a custom made mouthpiece which fits over your teeth. It prevents the lower jaw from dropping back during sleep, thus preventing the closure of your airways – an effective stop snoring remedy.

To calm your concerns, and create a soothing environment, we play relaxing music and for the very apprehensive, your treatment can be carried out under sedation from a tablet taken just beforehand or more profoundly with light intravenous sedation. Your hygiene treatment can be carried out with an anaestheic jelly, just dripped onto the gums.

Some restorative treatment requires no drilling and no injections - ask if micro-
